UPDATE FROM THE TEMPLE COMMITTEE



We hope you are as excited as we are about the sprucing up that is going on at our church! While our ministries and missions are always the main United Methodist Church focus of our congregation, we believe it is also

important to honor God's house by keeping our church looking its best. We pray that you will feel led to support this project financially and with your time and talents. Thank you!!!

Completed projects to date, labor donated by church members:

- Paint Education wing hallway
- Replace sanctuary AC fence
- Replace Parsonage fence
- Clean out outside sheds
- Update landscaping (on-going project)

Future projects when funds are available, costs are noted.

- Pressure wash church exterior and playground equipment: \$900
- Replace other AC fences outside: \$600 each (\$1200)
- Replace trash shed (Cromwell side) \$1000
- Replace orange lights on outside sanctuary wall (WI Road side): \$1000
- Replace outside awnings: \$300 \$350 each (\$2000)
- Install kick plates education wing doors: \$30 each (16 doors = \$480)
- Install kick stops for education wing doors: \$8 each (16 doors = \$128)
- Install faux wood blinds education wing: \$70 each (20 windows = \$1400)
- Repair ceiling, replace insulation, paint, and de-clutter closet across from choir room: \$1450
- Paint building exterior including doors, railings, and sign: \$15,000

Hello, Church! Like all music directors this time of year, I have been listening to A LOT of music leading up to the Easter season. There are so

many good options out there for chancel choir, handbells, and praise band, but what I was really looking for isn't just what is going to be catchy. I wanted depth and meaning in our musical offerings, and my favorite selection for this season has to be King of Kings, by Hillsong Worship. I knew from the first time that I heard this song, that this was a must for Easter Sunday!

Unlike some contemporary praise and worship songs, this song has four, very distinct verses. Instead of repetitions of a chorus or of a bridge to emphasize the message, King of Kings tells the Easter story in these verses with only one short chorus sung throughout. "Praise the Father, Praise the Son, Praise the Holy Spirit, three in one. God of Glory, Majesty. Praise forever to the King of Kings." Pure, simple, and the perfect message of Easter.

I highly encourage each of you to listen to King of Kings by Hillsong Worship simply to experience the beautiful storytelling. Even if contemporary worship music isn't your favorite, I think you will find this song to be particularly powerful. I also ask that you go ahead and learn these words, because your worship leader may start to cry tears of joy on Easter Sunday!! :) I can't wait to look out onto a full sanctuary on Easter Sunday, and praise forever to the King of Kings!
