## PASTOR'S PEN by Rev. Doug Walker

#### **How to Strengthen Our Church!**

- 1. **Be at Peace with each other** (Ephesians 4:3). How would our church change if bickering, complaining and cliques ended?
- 2. **Love one another** (John 13:34). This kind of love is unselfish and sacrificial. What would the relationships in our church look like if people truly practice this kind of love?
- 3. **Honor one another** (Roman 12:10). Christ honored even the most lowly of people. How would our church be strengthened if people treated one another that way?
- 4. **Accept one another** (Romans 15:7). It is not the job of Christians to change other people; transforming them is God's responsibility. How would relationships in our congregation change if people accept others as they are?
- 5. **Carry each other's burdens** (Galatians 6:2)! This means willingly and humbly walking beside others when they are hurting or struggling. Would community be strengthened within our congregation if people demonstrated sincere care for others who are suffering?
- 6. **Be patient with one another** (Ephesians 4:2)! Patience is about not giving up on others. What kinds of relationships would exist in your church if people were this gracious to each other?
- 7. **Forgive each other** (Colossians 3:13) Harboring a grudge creates stressed and unbalanced relationships. Could members of our congregation really let go of ego and pride to forgive each other for the sake of strengthening our church family?
- 8. **Teach and admonish one another** (Colossians 3:16) If people in our church are filled with worldly ideas about relationships, that is the kind of community you are going to have. But what would our church look like if our people were filled with what God's Word says about relationships?
- 9. **Encourage each other** (1 Thessalonians 5:11) This is one reason why relationships exist. Can the people of your church put words behind how they sincerely feel for each other expressing love, care and appreciation for each other?

As we move into the season of Lent, let these questions challenge us to GROW!
